## **Important Things to Know About Confirmation Camp At Imago Dei Village**

### The Motse System

*Motse* is the Setswana word for *village*. A motse consists of two cabins—generally one male cabin and one female cabin. Throughout the week, cabins within the motse do all of their activities together. For the most part, we try to keep all kids from one congregation in the same motse, however sometimes we do have to split them up if the group is large.

Each motse is in charge of planning its own afternoon schedules. Every day the motse will gather to discuss what activities they would like to do the next day. In the evening community meeting representatives from each motse meet to combine their schedules on our community board, and work together to make adjustments to the overall afternoon schedule. Since some activities such as waterfront and bike trips can only take so many people, the motse representatives sometimes have to compromise to make the puzzle come together.

### Club Time

This is YOUR time as pastors and youth workers to show who you are outside of just leading Bible study. Help your youth see you as a real person in addition to a pastor or youth worker.
